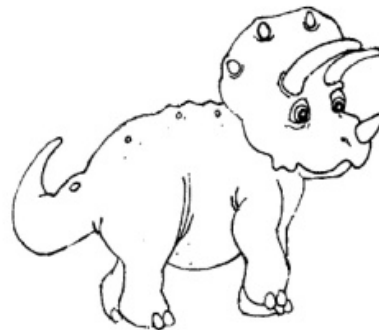


Create a compound sentence in the first exercise and a complex sentence in the second exercise.

turtle,"

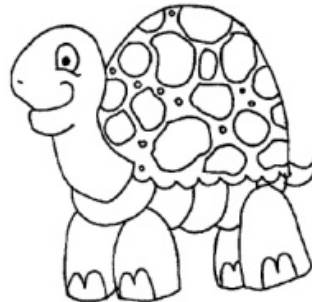
