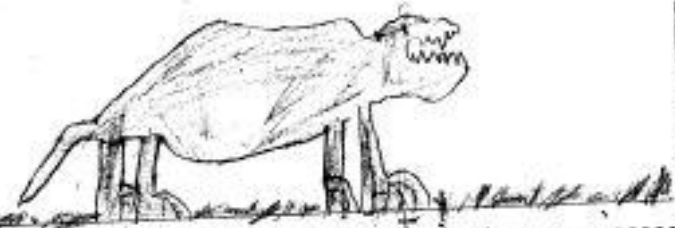


# Roary by a grade one student

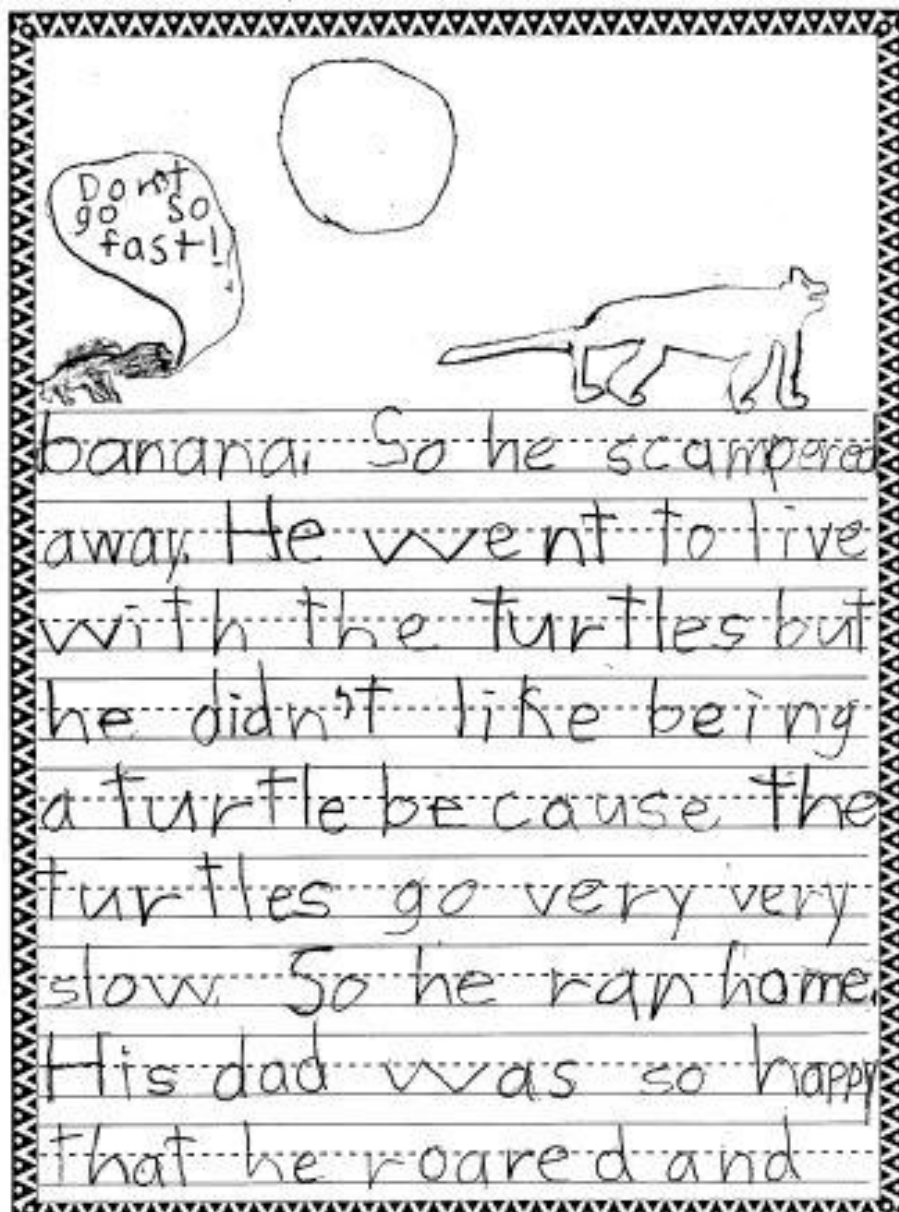
