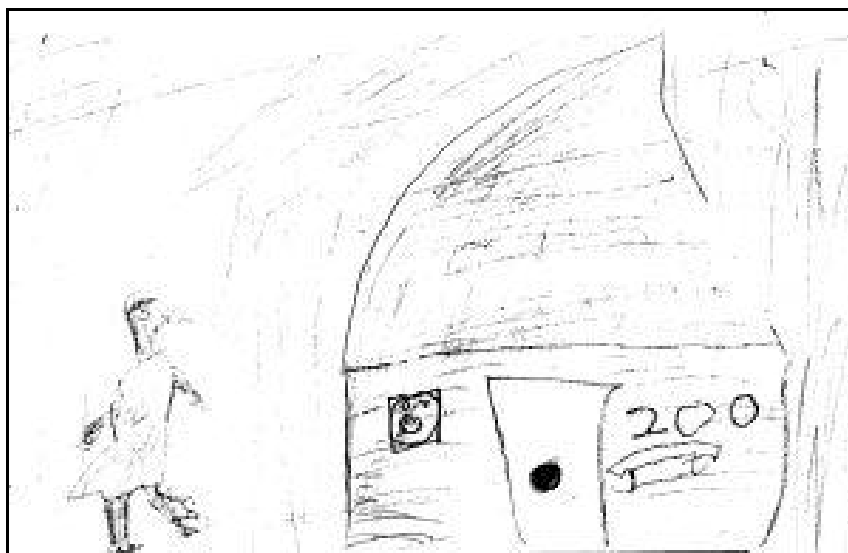


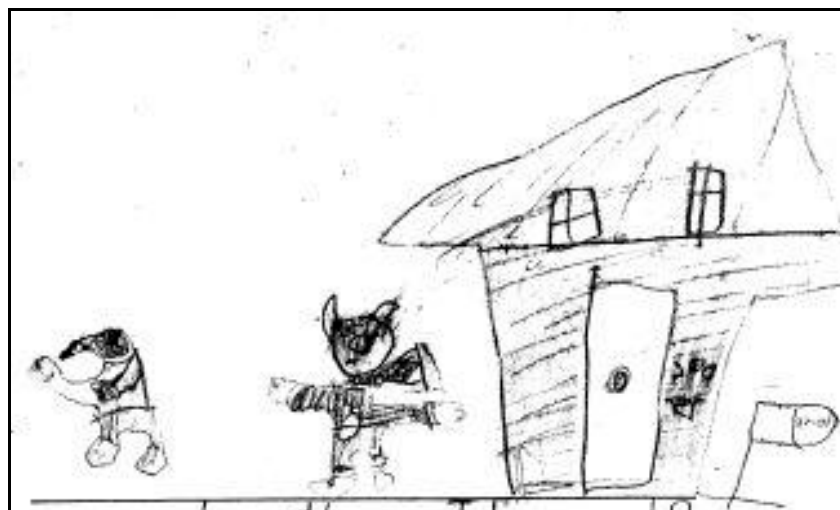
The Wolf's Adventure by a grade one student

a grade one student, to share this story with you.

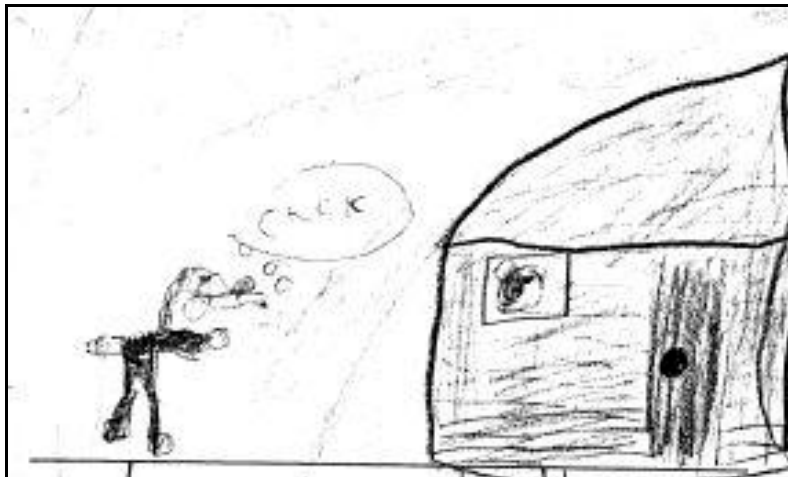
The Wolf's Adventure is a sequel to The Three Little Pigs. The student wrote about three other reasons that the Wolf might have failed in capturing the three little pigs.
