Compare with: grate

Compare with: hole

Sight Word: neighbor

Compare with: neigh

Sentence: Our neighbor's horse likes to neigh.

Sight Word: pull

Compare with: push

Sentence: Pull or push the wagon up the hill.

Sight Word: thumb
Compare with: dumb
Sentence: Hitting your thumb with a hammer was dumb.

Sight Word: climb
Compare with: limb
Sentence: Climb on the strongest limb of the tree.

Sight Word: neighbor
Compare with: neigh
Sentence: Our neighbor's horse likes to neigh.

Sight Word: beautiful
Compare with: beauty
Sentence: The beauty of that beautiful flower is indescribable.

Sight Word: ever
Compare with: every, even, never
Sentence: Never, ever get even with any dinosaurs you meet.

Sight Word: whole
Compare with: hole
Sentence: That whole melon fell in the hole.

Sight Word: learn
Compare with: earn
Sentence: If you learn from your mistakes you will earn wisdom.

Sight Word: show
Compare with: shoe
Sentence: Show me your shoe!

Sight Word: which
Compare with: rich, niche
Sentence: Which niche do you think will make you rich?

Sight Word: fierce
Compare with: fires, fiery
Sentence: Fierce fires are fiery.

Sight Word: rhyme
Compare with: rhyming, rhythm
Sentence: Make up a rhyme with a rhyming rhythm.

Sight Word: piece
Compare with: peace, pieces
Sentence: Divide your piece of peaces into more pieces.

Sight Word: hear
Compare with: here
Sentence: Can you hear with your ear? I am over here.

Sight Word: alone
Compare with: lone
Sentence: That lone bunny lives alone.

Sight Word: echo
Compare with: echoed, echoes
Sentence: That echo echoed up and down the valley. Echoes can be soft.

Sight Word: alive

Compare with: live (2), lived

Sentence: That live frog is alive. Let it live. It has already lived a long time.

Sight Word: quite

Compare with: quiet, quit

Sentence: Don't quite being quite quiet.

Sight Word: lose

Compare with: loose

Sentence: Don't lose the loose noose on that wild moose.

Sight Word: guessed

Compare with: guest

Sentence: I should have guessed who your guest was.

Sight Word: ache

Compare with: aching, ached

Sentence: That ache ached terribly and was aching for a long time.

Sight Word: money

Compare with: honey

Sentence: How much money is that honey?

Sight Word: carry

Compare with: tarry

Sentence: Do not tarry or you will have to carry your bag.

Sight Word: their

Compare with: heir

Sentence: That is their heir.

Sight Word: machine

Compare with: magician

Sentence: The magician hid in the machine.

Sight Word: taught

Compare with: caught, daughter

Sentence: My daughter taught us how to fish and we caught one.

Sight Word: fought

Compare with: thought, bought, brought

Sentence: In war the soldiers thought, fought and brought a peace bought with their lives.

Sight Word: through

Compare with: though, threw

Sentence: I through the ball threw the hole in the fence though I knew it would cause trouble.

Sight Word: though

Compare with: thought, thorough

Sentence: Though it takes time, be thorough in your thought.

Sight Word: walk

Compare with: talk, stalk, chalk

Sentence: A teacher can talk, walk, and draw a sunflower stalk with her chalk.

Sight Word: they

Compare with: hey

Sentence: Hey! They are leaving.
