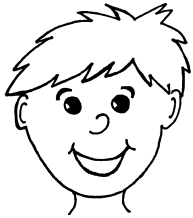

Forehead - wrinkled/scrunched

Face - turned white as a sheet/ghost/blanched

Eyebrows - raised/shot up

Eyes - widened/bulged/bugged out/slammed shut/narrowed/eyelids fluttered

Ears -

Nose - nostrils flared/nose twitched

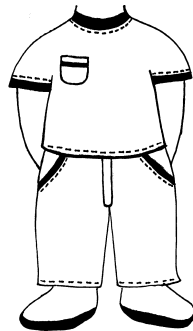
Mouth - sucked in breath/whistled low/swallowed hard

Tongue - bit/licked nervously

Lips - pursed/bit/pressed lips tightly together

Head - bowed/hair rose/stood on end/bristled

Hands - wrung/shook/held/knotted

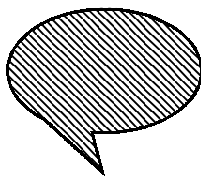
Legs - shook/trembled/wobbled/

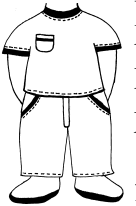
